Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and Sealand Contractors Corp. continue with construction. There was a delay with relocating private utilities, but work is progressing. Construction is anticipated to be completed by fall 2020.

### **Construction updates**

Replacement of the sanitary sewer line on Margaret Turner Road is complete and crews continue to replace the connecting lines. Relocation of the sanitary sewer line was necessary to accommodate storm drainage improvements that will begin in late January.

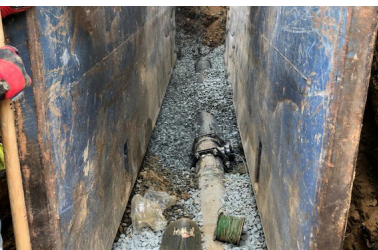
