**Dear Resident,**

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services will begin construction soon. On November 26, 2018, City Council awarded the construction contract to Sealand Contractors Corp. Construction is scheduled to start in March and is estimated to take one year.

During the next few weeks these activities may be underway:

- Locating, flagging, marking and relocating utilities
- Trimming select trees to accommodate construction equipment

This kind of work uses heavy-duty construction vehicles including dump trucks, concrete trucks and excavators, all of which can be loud during operations. The contractor may keep equipment within the work area for the duration of the project. One of the goals of the construction planning process is to minimize disruptions and maintain local access and traffic flow. When it is necessary to detour traffic temporarily, signs will assist motorists. An inspector will be on site daily to address any questions or concerns.
