Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and City of Charlotte Real Estate staff will be starting easement acquisition in the next month for the Marlwood/Waverly Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Dewberry, consulting engineer, has recently completed more field investigation in the area of the pond, and is working on the preliminary design plans. The preliminary design and easement acquisition will run concurrently. Final design plans will not be created until all easements are obtained.
