

Myrtle/Morehead Phase 2 Storm Drainage Improvement Project Meeting Minutes

Dear Resident,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services held three open house events on January 24 and 26 at Pritchard Memorial Baptist Church for residents to learn more about the upcoming stormwater and wastewater improvements in the neighborhood. Construction began this month and is estimated to take three years.

Meeting highlights

- Chad Nussman, Project Manager, introduced the project team, gave a project overview and explained the construction process.
- Storm drainage improvements throughout the neighborhood will include: realigning and upsizing the existing pipe systems, adding pipes and inlets to capture street drainage and abandoning sections of existing drainage systems.
- Work will start on the Charlotte Housing Authority property located on Euclid Avenue and also at the intersection of Oriole Street and Lexington Avenue.
- The trunk line for the storm drainage system will be installed using a tunneling operation along Lexington, Myrtle, Templeton and Euclid Avenues.
- A question/answer session was held as well as breakout sessions to review individual construction plan sheets.

Question and Answers

- *Who should I contact during construction?* Michael Lopez, Construction Inspector, will be on site daily to address any questions or concerns.
- *Will traffic be impacted?* Some intersections will be closed for extended timeframes in order to tunnel the stormwater pipe. Streets with active construction will generally be closed to through traffic.
- *Will I lose driveway access to my property?* Driveway access will be limited while crews are working on the one-to-two block area. Crews will provide temporary access as soon as possible.
- *Will there be impacts to on street parking?* Parking may be reduced to one side of the street or eliminated in order to provide safe access for construction vehicles. Project team members will be glad to discuss site specific parking needs to accommodate residents.
