Project Status

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and engineering consultant Woolpert, have finalized the construction plans and documents needed for construction. The project is currently in the bid phase. During this phase the final plans are circulated to qualified contractors for a competitive bidding process. Staff anticipates City Council awarding the contract in late August. Once the contract is awarded, construction will begin.

Next Steps

Construction is anticipated to begin in the fall and take approximately three years to complete. Once a contract is in place, more detailed information will be communicated to the property owners.
