Dear Resident:

On August 11, construction of the Tattersall Storm Drainage Improvement Project was put on hold due to private utility conflicts. While great care was taken during the project design and construction planning process to minimize the need for private utility relocations (gas, electric, phone, and internet), some utility relocations are required before construction can move forward.

As a result of COVID-19, many private utility providers limited or suspended service interruptions. This has created a backlog of utility relocation requests and increased wait times. While each private utility company is responsible for executing relocations and notifying residents, Storm Water Services coordinates closely with these private partners.

At this time, we cannot provide a specific date when construction will resume, but we will notify you in advance. Please contact me if you have any questions or concerns related to this project. Project information is also available online at **StormWater.CharMeck.org**.
