Storm Drainage Improvement Project

Dear Resident,

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services will begin construction soon. On November 26, 2018, City Council awarded the construction contract to Sealand Contractors Corp. Construction is estimated to take less than one year and is expected to start on Gavin Drive.

During the next few weeks the following construction related activities may be underway:

- Locating, flagging and marking utilities for relocation and
- Trimming select trees to accommodate construction equipment.

This kind of work uses heavy-duty construction vehicles including dump trucks, concrete trucks and excavators, all of which can be loud during operations. The contractor may keep equipment within the work area for the duration of the project. During the construction planning process utilities, local access and traffic flow were considered to minimize disruptions. When it is necessary to detour traffic temporarily, signs will assist motorists.
