**Project Status**

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services and Calyx (formerly Mulkey) Engineers & Consultants are working on identifying utility and design modifications necessary to accommodate a needed water main relocation along North Sharon Amity Road. Following redesign, utility coordination meetings with various other private utility owners will be held to incorporate any final utility relocation needs.

**Next Steps**

Calyx Engineers will incorporate all utility relocations and design modifications in the overall preliminary design plans, which will be used to prepare plats necessary to acquire easements. Once completed we will schedule a public meeting to share the preliminary design plans and kick off the easement acquisition phase. Meeting details will be mailed to residents approximately two weeks prior to the meeting.

Charlotte has an aging public storm drainage system, much of which is past its useful life. The City repairs, replaces and installs new storm drainage infrastructure when it deteriorates or becomes too small to handle increases in stormwater. Investing in infrastructure protects public safety, guards private property, improves water quality and enhances quality of life.

The Water Oak Storm Drainage Improvement Project goals are to reduce street and structure flooding throughout the neighborhood and address stream erosion to provide a more natural, stable stream system.
