COMMITTEE TO RECEIVE INPUT ON WATER QUALITY ISSUES AND THE
ACTIONS CURRENTLY UNDERTAKEN TO COMPLY WITH NPDES PHASE II
STORM WATER PERMIT REQUIREMENTS IN MECKLENBURG COUNTY

Notice is hereby given that a public meeting will be held by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Advisory Committee in the Hal Marshall meeting room #407 located on the 4th floor of the Land Use & Environmental Services' building at 2145 Suttle Avenue in Charlotte on July 15, 2021 at 4:30 p.m. The purpose of this meeting is to receive public input concerning water quality issues in Mecklenburg County and the actions currently undertaken by Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services to comply with the NPDES Phase II Storm Water Permit requirements for Mecklenburg County, Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools, Central Piedmont Community College and the Towns of Cornelius, Davidson, Huntersville, Matthews, Mint Hill, and Pineville. Comments and input received will be considered by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Advisory Committee and the staff of Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services in the evaluation of water quality program activities in preparation for submittal of an application to the N.C. Department of Environmental Quality for renewal of NPDES Phase II Storm Water Permit number NCS000395. This application will be submitted no later than August 20, 2021.

Interested parties and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard and may obtain information regarding the actions currently undertaken by Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services to comply with NPDES Phase II Storm Water Permit requirements from the Mecklenburg County Land Use and Environmental Services Agency, 2145 Suttle Avenue in Charlotte, (980) 314-3217.
