## CENTER CITY FOOD TRUCK PROGRAM For Operation on City Streets

Starting June 15, 2016, the City of Charlotte will allow food trucks to operate on uptown streets in designated *Food Truck Activity Areas* (see map on reverse side).

In order to operate your food truck in uptown, you must contact Charlotte Center City Partners. They will guide you through the registration and permitting process.

### 2. REGISTER

Charlotte Center City Partners will guide you through the registration process.

### 3. GET A PERMIT

A **\$300** permit, called a *Temporary Infrastructure Agreement* (TIA), is required and is valid for one year. It allows you to occupy space within designated *Food Truck Activity Areas* (see map on reverse side).

# CENTER CITY FOOD TRUCK PROGRAM

For Operation on City Streets

The regulations apply only to food trucks operating on City streets in uptown.

Charlotte Center City Partners (CCCP) manages this program on behalf of the Charlotte Department of Transportation. CCCP will establish and maintain a schedule to assign food truck operators to approved *Food Truck Activity Areas* (see map below). Contact CCCP for details about the process and requirements to operate your food truck on uptown streets.

## FEES

- \$300 annual permit (TIA)
- \$15 per day for use of metered parking space

## REQUIRED PERMITS

1. Temporary Infrastructure Agreement (TIA)
2. Mobile Food Unit Permit from Mecklenburg County\*
3. Time & Location Schedule

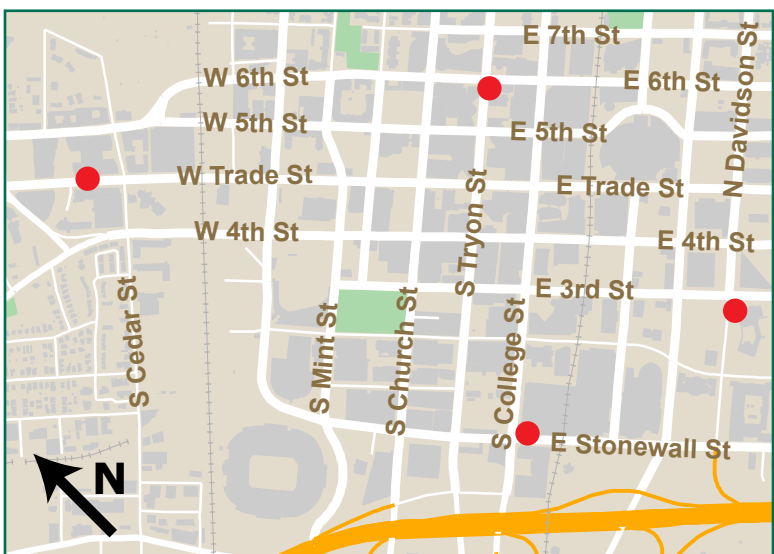
