



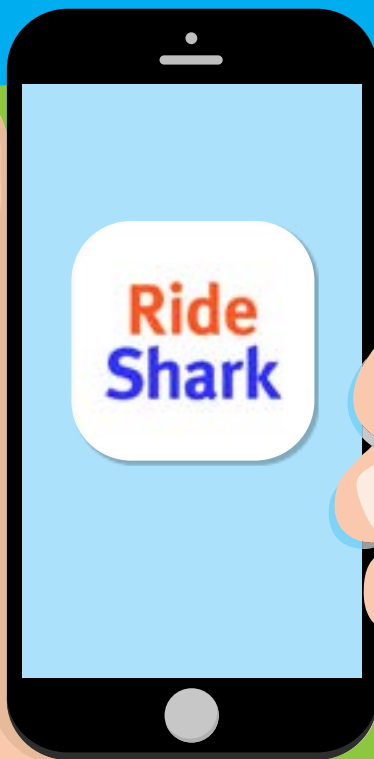

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

You will still be able to log and earn rewards for your alternative commutes; however, it will be on a new platform and app. Don't worry though – all your data, trips logged and account information will be switched over automatically to the new system. So, you or your network will be able to see the completed statistics from your lifetime involved with Way2Go CLT under the Share The Ride NC platform.

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO DO:

1. Be on the lookout for updates and tutorials. We want to ensure the transition is smooth and that users understand the new platform before the completed transition.
2. Download the new app by January 1, 2020. The new app is called **RideShark Ridesharing App** and will be the new mobile platform that you will use.

HOLIDAY BUS IS BACK!

CATS is sharing the holiday spirit again with you by operating buses decorated for the holidays. Starting in December, look for one of the blue holiday themed buses on your route. When this special bus arrives on your trip, rides are FREE. The buses will be rotated throughout the system, so they'll be put on different routes during the month of December. CATS ROUTES USING EXPRESS LANES

Beginning Monday, November 25, CATS began utilizing the I-77 express lanes for bus routes 48X Northcross Express, 53X Northlake Express and 77X North Mecklenburg Express. There will be no additional cost to riders.

SCALEYBARK PARK AND RIDE RELOCATING

On Monday, December 2, the Scaleybark Park and Ride will be relocated to the parking lot on Dewitt Lane. Customers commuting via South Blvd. can access the new park and ride by turning on Whitton Street then left onto Dewitt Lane. The new park and ride will be on the left. Any remaining cars in the current Scaleybark Park and Ride will be towed.

CENTER-CITY WILL SEE MORE GOLD LINE CONSTRUCTION

As we move closer to the end of major construction in Summer 2020, we will see track work move closer to Center-City. This will require a number of long-term road closures through major intersections such as Church Street and Trade Street, Tryon Street and Trade Street, and College Street and Trade Street.
