### *Increased Express Bus Service*

As of July 12, CATS added additional morning and evening trips and improve service span and/or increase frequency along the following routes:

- [Route 40X Lawyers Road Express](#) – one morning trip and one evening trip will be added.
- [Route 46X Harrisburg Road Express](#) – one morning trip and one evening trip will be added.
- [Route 48X Northcross Express](#) – added trips results in 20 – minute frequency for morning peak and evening peak services.
- [Route 52X Idlewild Road Express](#) – one morning trip and one evening trip will be added.
- [Route 53X Northlake Express](#) – two morning trips and two evening trips will be added.
- [Route 62X Rea Road Express](#) – one morning trip and one evening trip will be added.
- [Route 63X Huntersville Express](#) - added trips will result in 20 – minute frequency for morning peak and evening peak services.
- [Route 64X Independence Blvd](#) - added trips will result in increased frequency for morning peak and evening peak services.
- [Route 77X North Mecklenburg Express](#) - added trips will result in 20 – minute frequency for morning peak and evening peak services.
