### Crossing Gates

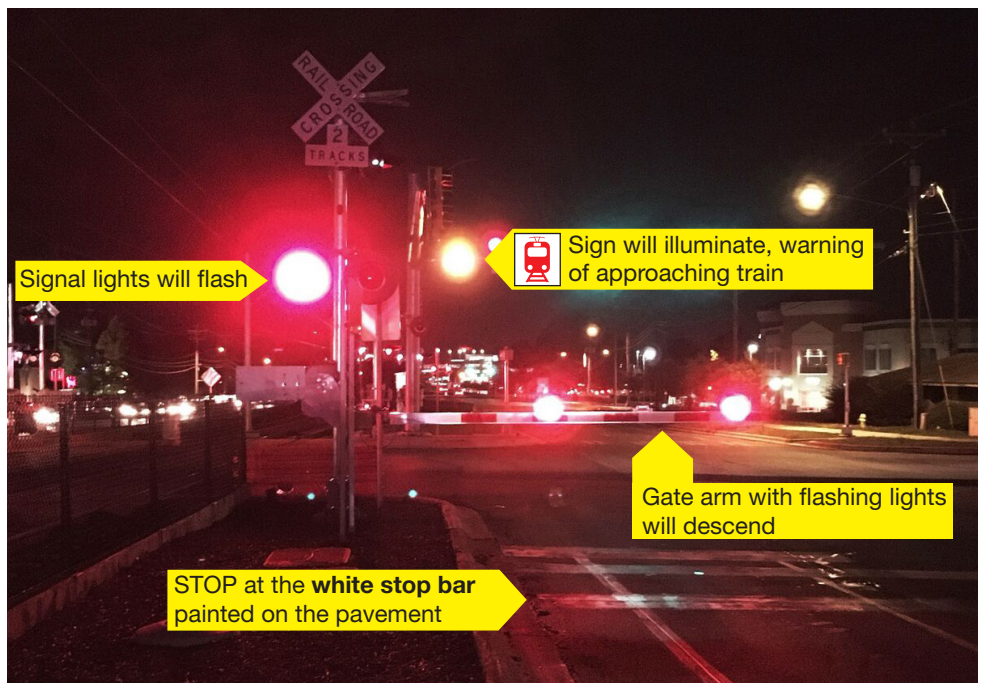
Please be mindful of all posted signage, traffic signals, crosswalks, and crossing gates! Crossing gates are a new addition to North Tryon Street. They notify motorists that a train will be crossing the intersection. First, the train sign posted to the traffic signals will illuminate, warning motorists of the approaching train. Then, the red lights on the crossing signal will flash and the gate arms will descend. When the red lights begin to flash, slow down and STOP at the white stop bar painted on the pavement. Do NOT proceed through the intersection until the gate arms have fully ascended and red lights stop flashing. If another train is approaching the intersection, the gate arms may descend before they have fully ascended.

- Always be prepared to STOP when approaching a railroad crossing.
- Do not go around crossing gates – it is illegal and dangerous!




When approaching a crossing signal and preparing to turn left, follow all traffic rules as normal.


If turning left and a train is approaching, the crossing signals will illuminate as shown. Observe all appropriate light rail safety procedures and traffic laws.
