Did you know you're supposed to maintain grass and vegetation all the way to the street?

City ordinance states that property owners are responsible to maintain grass and vegetation on rights of way. That includes planting strips (the strip of grass between the sidewalk and the street). Grass needs to be less than 12 inches tall, and vegetation can't block pedestrians, cyclists or motorists. Fines start at \$150 for violations.
