Commission Debrief.

Mr. Harlow reviewed the topics and background materials that the Commission has received since February, 2022.

Commission Work Streams

The Commission discussed the proposed Commission work streams. Three initial work streams were identified that will be areas of focus, along with the Commission members that will serve as leaders for each stream. Prior to the meeting, Commission members self-selected the work stream that they each desired to work in through a brief interest survey.

The three work streams and leaders of each include:

- 1. Lay of the Land Angela Ambroise (Lead)
- 2. Program Improvements and Policy Gaps Justin Harlow (Co-Chair/Lead)
- 3. Understanding the Impacts of the Unified Development Ordinance Kim Graham (Co-Chair/Lead)

The Commission determined that the opportunity to examine issues surrounding small business support through the lens of anti-displacement will be able to be addressed through these three work streams as needed, and can also be an areas of focus in the future.

Next Steps

The full Commission and the three smaller work stream groups will alternate meeting every other month. The work stream groups will convene in June, at which time each work stream will identify the initial priorities and work plans for their respective work stream. Mr. Harlow encouraged Commission members to review all of the meeting, pre-read and background materials that has already been made available to the Commission as it could help shape the work of the work streams. The full Commission will meet again in July, to receive and discuss each work stream's initial work plan.
