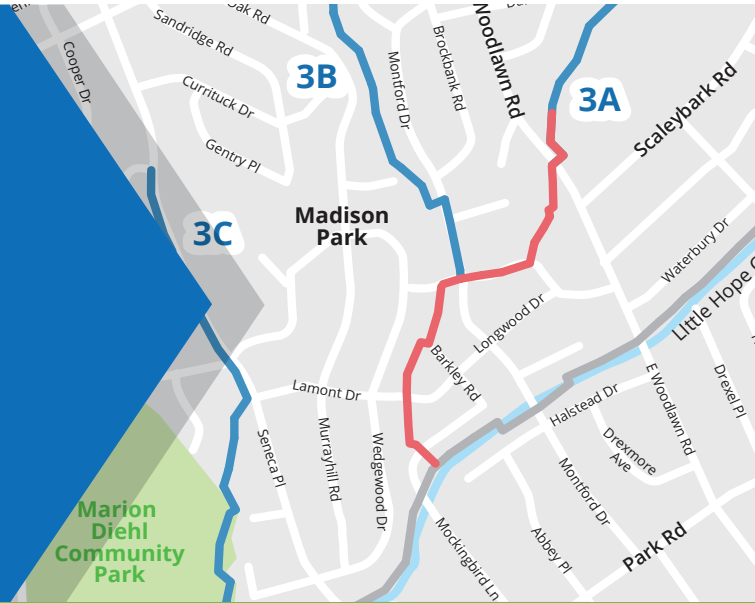

Construction Complete on Phase 3a.1

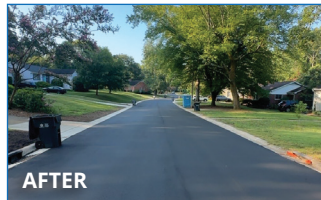
Charlotte Water and its contractors have completed construction on phase 3a.1 of the Little Hope Creek Wastewater Improvement Project. Phase 3a.1 involved installing more than 3,600 linear feet of wastewater pipeline in the Madison Park neighborhood, from Mockingbird Lane to East Woodlawn Road. This project expands the capacity of the wastewater system in the Sedgefield and Madison Park neighborhoods, reduces the risk of sanitary sewer overflows and protects the water quality in the Little Hope creek.

Crews began construction work for phase 3a.1 of this project along Woodlawn Road in February 2024 and completed pipe installation in the immediate area in September 2024.

Ongoing Restoration Activities

Restoration activities have been completed along most of the phase 3a.1 alignment, with reseeded activities to occur in the coming months when weather allows. Additionally, crews will be replacing grass and installing fences as needed.
