 - Only include information relevant to your community. For example, if you do not have a lift/pump station, remove that language from your O&M Plan.

✓ Develop a Site Map

• Illustrate manhole(s), lift/pump station, and clean out locations. Indicate the direction of flow in the sanitary sewer collection system.

✓ Submit your O&M Plan

• Submit plan to the inspector indicated in your letter or Lauren Bradley. Contact information is below.

✓ Implement the Plan

• Document the actions staff take in the inspection log so there is a record.

✓ Notify Charlotte Water BEFORE cleaning the sanitary sewer

Call 311 or (704) 336-7600 and ask for sewer dispatch prior to cleaning.

√ Report Sanitary Sewer Overflows

- Notify Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services if the overflow <u>reaches a storm drain, creek, or lake.</u>
- You are required by law to notify the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality <u>if the</u> <u>overflow is greater than 1,000 gallons or it reaches a creek.</u> Contact information is below.
