

HOPWA RFP Q & A

- Q. Please clarify, where are Delivery Costs for the Project Sponsor to be included in the Budget Worksheet? Should it be included in the direct delivery categories for STRMU, Case management, etc.?
- A. The Delivery Cost for the Project Sponsor portion should be included in the Case Management line item on the Proposed Project Sponsor Budget Worksheet.
- Q. Are there text character/word limitations for each entry? If yes, what are they?
- A. No, there is no text character/word limitation for responses.
- Q. Is there a required font and /or font size to be used for entering the text? If yes, what is it?
- A. No, there is no required font and font size.
- Q. Must all services covered by HOPWA be available in all 11 counties? Or just one or a few services that are deemed by the community as community needs be provided in the counties?
- A. All eligible HOPWA activities listed in the FY2025 HOPWA RFP must be available to HOPWA-eligible residents in the eleven county service area.
- Q. Can you please share how much \$ was granted in the last cycle for each of the service areas?
- A. We do not have the funds awarded broken out by service area/county as many of the the organizations awarded funds serve multiple counties.
- Q. How many payments were made through STRMU?
- A. During the FY2024 performance period, the agencies offering STRMU services proposed to assist 324 households.

Q. Is it required that TBRA be administered by the Project Sponsor? Or can it be contracted out to another entity with oversight from the Project Sponsor?

A. The City currently intends for the Project Sponsor to administer the TBRA program. Discussion on administering the program a different way would need to occur prior to the contract process.

Q. How many units are being funded by TBRA?

A. During the performance period of FY 2024, approximately 83 households were assisted through the HOPWA TBRA program.
