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# AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CHARLOTTE, NORTH CAROLINA

WHEREAS, the City Council has been petitioned under G.S. 160A-31(a) to annex the area described below; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has by Resolution directed the City Clerk to investigate the sufficiency of the petition; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has certified the sufficiency of the petition and a public hearing on the question of this annexation was held during a meeting that was accessible at the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center at 6:30 p.m. on September 9, 2024 after due notice by the Mecklenburg Times on August 27, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the petition meets the requirements of G.S. 160A-31;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Charlotte, North Carolina that:

Section 1. By virtue of the authority granted by G.S. 160A-31, the following described territory is hereby annexed and made part of the City of Charlotte as of September 9, 2024.

# **LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

Beginning at a disk on boulders found along the Mecklenburg and Cabarrus County line; being described as point 3029 as shown on Map Book 39, Page 199 in the Mecklenburg County Registry; having a North Carolina State Plane Coordinate (NAD83) of

Section 2. Upon and after September 9, 2024 the above described territory and its citizens and property shall be subject to all debts, laws, ordinances and regulations in force in the City of Charlotte and shall be entitled to the same

privileges and benefits as other parts of the City of Charlotte. Said territory shall be subject to municipal taxes according to G.S.160A-58.10.

Section 3. Subject to change in accordance with applicable law, the annexed territory described above shall be included in the following Council electoral district 4.

Section 4. The Mayor of the City of Charlotte shall cause to be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Mecklenburg County, and in the office of the Secretary of State at Raleigh, North Carolina, an accurate map of the annexed territory, described in Section 1 above, together with a duly certified copy of this ordinance. Such a map shall also be delivered to the Mecklenburg County Board of Elections, as required by G.S. 163-288.1.






VOLUNTARY ANNEXATION MAP OF
