




ADDENDUM TO PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY

Pursuant to the State of Emergency Proclamation issued on September 21, 2016, by City of Charlotte Mayor Jennifer Roberts and Chairman Trevor Fuller of the Board of County Commissioners within the City of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County, and in order to more effectively protect the lives and property of the people within the City of Charlotte, to place in effect one of the restrictions authorized by the Code of Ordinances of the City of Charlotte, Section 15-20, specifically the authority to define and impose a curfew: I hereby exercise by authority to implement the following provisions set forth below:

Curfew. Beginning September 23, 2016 a curfew will be imposed at midnight until 6:00 am each evening and to continue until the end of the State of Emergency is declared or until this Proclamation is revoked, within the corporate limits of the City of Charlotte to prohibit travel upon any public street, alley, or roadway or upon any other public property, except by those in search of medical assistance, food or other commodity or service necessary to sustain the well-being of themselves or their families or some other member thereof with the following exemptions:

- (1) Law enforcement officers, firefighters and other public employees:
- (2) Doctors, nurses, employees of hospitals and medical facilities:
- (3) On-duty military personnel, whether state or federal:
- (4) On-duty employees of public utilities, public transportation companies, and newspaper, magazine, radio broadcasting, and television broadcasting corporations operated for profit:
and
- (5) Such other classes of person as may be essential to the preservation of public order and immediately necessary to serve the safety, health, and welfare needs of the people within the city.
