Sir or Ma'am,

Over the past several months the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department (CMPD) has placed an increased emphasis on investigating violations of, but not limited to, the following North Carolina General Statutes (NCGS):

- NCGS §20-141.6: "Aggressive Driving,"
- NCGS §20-140: "Reckless Driving," and
- NCGS §20-141.3: "Unlawful Racing on Streets and Highways."

As a result of these investigations we have determined that your vehicle has been present at locations when organized aggressive driving, reckless driving, and/or unlawful racing is taking place. Punishment for the above listed offenses could include: citations, fines, court fees, arrests and seizure of your vehicle.

**This letter is to place you on notice that any additional involvement in these activities or being present at locations where these activities are occurring, could result in an investigation into you and/or your vehicle. The CMPD recommends that you immediately cease any illegal activity and follow all motor vehicle laws as defined by the State of North Carolina.**
