WEST BOULEVARD CORRIDOR VISION

For over twenty years, the City of Charlotte has invested in corridors because of the critical role each plays in supplying basic needs and opportunities for their communities.

In partnership with the West Boulevard Neighborhood Coalition, the City of Charlotte Government is leading a study that will serve as a first step in providing a vision for the corridor focused on the intersections of Remount, Clanton and Old Steele Creek. In these workshops we will discuss what we've learned about the existing corridor, identify opportunities for investment and envision future change. Help us create a shared vision for West Boulevard as a vibrant corridor into the city.
